Contra Costa County Welcomes New Affirmative Action Officer

County Administrator David Twa today welcomed veteran human resources professional Antoine Wilson as Contra Costa's Affirmative Action/Equal Employment Opportunity Officer. Wilson began his new position September 10, 2012, joining the County with more than a decade of experience in managing a wide range of government human resources programs and services. Most recently, he was a lead senior investigator for CalTrans, conducting major personnel investigations, training staff on grievance and policy issues, and enforcing state and federal discrimination laws.

"Antoine Wilson brings a strong background in state and local government human resources to our team," Twa said, "with expertise in areas that will enhance Contra Costa's strong commitment to building a diverse workforce." Twa added that his track record with CalTrans, the Department of Fair Employment and Housing, and the Division of Labor Standards and Enforcement with the State's Industrial Relations Department shows a broad range of talent that will help the County with community outreach and strengthening our current affirmative action practices.

For his part, Wilson is eager to serve the County and community. "I am excited to serve as the Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity Officer, and look forward to working in a County where diversity, equality and fairness are principles held in the highest regard in the administration," he stated.

Wilson replaces former Affirmative Action Officer Emma Kuevor, who retired last year after more than 35 years of service to the County.
