Summary for February 2023

The Blackhawk and Valley Station Deputies either initiated or responded to the following calls for service:

- 391 ~ Total calls for service in Blackhawk.
- 3 ~ Total police reports were taken in Blackhawk.

There were no felonies reported in the district.

There were 2 misdemeanors reported in the district.

1. On 2/5/23, deputies responded to a male lying on the sidewalk, possibly “passed out,” near the Silver Oaks entrance. The adult male was extremely intoxicated and arrested for public intoxication. He was booked at the MDF.
2. On 2/28/23, a resident reported an unknown suspect attempted to use his credit card number for an on-line purchase. The transaction was not authorized, and the victim suffered no financial loss.
