## 4. Items for Discussion and/or Action

Many questions have been raised within the community at both BIMAC and BIMID meetings over the last several months. Below is a summary of the questions for discussion.

- a. Explain storm drain responsibility on Bethel Island.
  - County
  - BIMID
  - Private property owners
- b. Where are private property owners supposed to channel excess water during a storm event?
- c. Can private property owners pump water over the roadway into a storm drain inlet on the other side of the road?
- d. Who owns the storm drain inlets connected to County culverts under the streets? Who maintains them?
- e. Who owns the ditches along the roadway? Who maintains them?
- f. If a private property owner has made changes to their property that directly affect the flow water and/or fills in a ditch, who addresses these issues with the private property owner? What's the process?
- g. Did Delta Coves construction change the drainage and seepage on Stone Road?
- h. Where do private property owners discharge their sump pumps from levee leakage?
- i. What is the process to involve the County to add culverts and storm drain inlets where none exist but are needed?



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
