Summary for May 2023

The Blackhawk and Valley Station Deputies either initiated or responded to the following calls for service:

- 324 ~ Total calls for service in Blackhawk.
- 10 ~ Total police reports taken in Blackhawk.

There were 2 felonies reported in the district.

1. On 5/15/23, it was discovered that a large mirror in the vacant "Crunch Fitness" was broken. It is unknown exactly when the damage occurred. There were no signs of a break-in at the location, and no evidence or suspect identification was obtained. The mirror was valued at over \$400.
2. On 5/25/23, a trailer was damaged while parked in a maintenance lot near the Sports Complex. The suspect(s) threw a paver stone several times into the siding of the trailer, causing multiple dents and holes exceeding \$400 in damage. The case has been forwarded for further investigation.

There was 1 misdemeanor reported in the district.

1. On 5/30/23, Plaza security reported that two exit signs inside the vacant "Blackhawk Movies Seven" cinema were damaged. The damage did not exceed \$400.
