Incident Summary

- On 9/22/23, Deputy Smith was dispatched to an address on Sugar Creek Lane for the report of a residential burglary. The victim was not home during the burglary and was notified by her neighbor the home had been burglarized. An unknown suspect broke into the residence and stole approximately \$120,000.00 worth of jewelry and \$20,000.00 in cash. Deputy Smith requested the assistance of the Contra Costa County Crime Lab and Sheriff's Office Detectives. Evidence was collected by the crime lab and was booked for testing and review. Video surveillance was also collected and sent to the High-Tech Crimes Unit for further review. FLOCK cameras identified a possible suspect vehicle which entered Roundhill at 1939 hours, and later entered Roundhill North at 1941 hours. The vehicle was a silver 2015 Infiniti Q50 with a paper dealer plate which read, "HOBLIT". The investigation is ongoing and there are no suspects, witnesses or leads at the time of this report.
