Summary for September 2023

The Blackhawk and Valley Station Deputies either initiated or responded to the following calls for service:

There were no felonies reported in the district.

1. On 9/3/23, a misdemeanor domestic battery occurred inside a residence. The suspect in the battery was arrested and booked at the Martinez Detention Facility.
