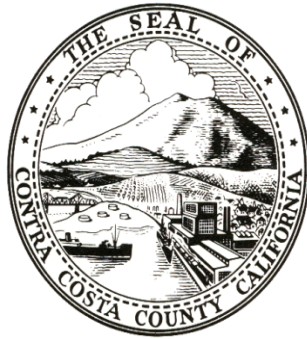

5. Agency Reports

- a. **Supervisor Glover** – Vincent reported that we will be in person for the April Meeting.
- b. **Sheriff's Office – Deputy Diaz** – Deputy Diaz introduced himself as the new Resident Deputy. He said he has been working on clean-ups with Code Enforcement and we are still waiting on the cameras. Gang graffiti has been on the rise but not gang activity.
- c. **Code Enforcement – Joe Lasado** – Joe reported that they opened 43 cases, closed 37 and have a total of 82 current cases. They keep moving the homeless from place to place. Illegal dumping continues to be a problem but he has had some success in catching people from addressed found in the debris. They started their "Walkabout" program in February the Home Acres area, he shared a slide show of the improvements made. He encouraged residents to use the Mobile app to report problems it has been very effective.
- d. **Contra Costa Fire Protection – Steve Hill** – Steve reported the fire station in Pinole will be opening. There have been issues with downed trees during the storms. Two engines were taken out of service by car accidents, one is repairable but the other is a loss. They had 28 graduates from the Fire Academy, it is a 20 week course. They have 3 new Deputy Chiefs.
- e. **Golden State Water – Tina Gonzalez** – Tina reported that they continue with their regular maintenance and are grateful for the rain.
