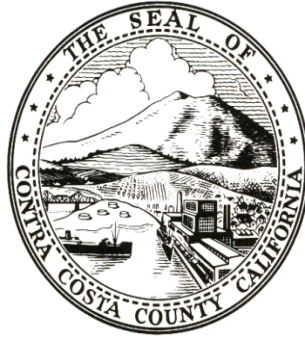

5. Agency Reports

- a. **Supervisor Glover** – Vincent/Jo-Anmarie Ricasata reminded people of the clean-up event
- b. **Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office – Lt. Meth** – reported that 217 bikes were given away at the Bike Rodeo last month. They placed 9 cameras last month throughout the community to catch people illegally dumping. He will be requesting more from Keller Mitigation Fees. Crime is down, there was a homicide last week, and several fentanyl deaths. There is a firework ordinance and a direct line to call.
- c. **Contra Costa County Fire Protection District – Lon Gage**- Lon introduced himself and he is the Assistant Fire Chief in charge of 10-12 stations. They received a Safer Grant that will provide another Rescue company to be house at Station 86, with specialized fire fighters. They have a bulldozer staff to help with fire roads and a Hand Crew a Cadet Program.
- d. **Golden State Water – Tina Gonzalez** – Tina reported that they continue with their annual maintenance and weed abatement.

6. Presentation:

- a. **MOTCO – LTC Brown and Mr. Gamble** – LTC Brown introduced himself and gave a brief update on MOTCO. They will be mowing weeds and have a Fire Dept. on base. We can expect to see more fencing going up and they plan to a build out over the next 10-20 years on the eastern side of the base.
