5. Agency Reports

- a. **Supervisor Glover** – Supervisor Glover introduced Dr. McNitt from Contra Costa Health who gave us an update on the status of COVID 19 in Contra Costa County. She gave us statistics and update on changes to shelter-in-place. Vincent reported that the Storage facility application is moving through the county planning and will be coming back to the MAC.
- b. **Contra Costa Sheriff's Office – Lt. Paul O'Mary** – Lt. O'Mary was unable to join us because the Sheriff's are responding to a mutual aide request due to growing protests in the county.
- c. **Contra Costa Code Enforcement** - Joe Losado reported that in May they opened 23

new cases, closed 13, for a total of 172 cases. Complaints about homeless encampments are up.

- d. Golden State Water – Tina Gonzalez** – Tina reported that they have stopped all capital projects and are not interrupting anyone service at this time. Any issues will be dealt with after the shelter-in-place has been lifted. They are working staggered shifts for social distancing. They are continuing with annual maintenance.
