Continuum of Care (CoC) – designed to address homelessness through coordinated community-based process of identifying needs and building systems of housing and services.

CoC system include, at minimum:

- Street outreach Coordinated Outreach, Referral, Engagement (CORE)
- Engagement and assessment
- Shelter
- Housing
- Supportive services
- Homeless prevention strategies

Role of CoC – Planning body, promote goal of ending homelessness, provide funding, promote access to services, and optimize self-sufficiency.

CoC Advisory Board also known as "Council on Homelessness (CoH)", funded by Housing Urban Development (HUD) and members are approved by Board of Supervisors.

Contra Costa Health Services, Health, Housing & Homeless Services Division (H3) is the lead agency in the CoC structure.

CoC has three access points: 211, Coordinated Outreach, Referral, Engagement (CORE) Teams, and Care Centers

Opportunities to engage with CoC: participate in CoH monthly meetings, committees, workgroups, stakeholder meetings, CoC learning hubs, and/or become a provider. To sign up for mailing list, visit cchealth.org/h3
