Police Report: Lt. Schultz

1. 395 total calls
2. 15 Police Reports were taken in Blackhawk
3. 3 felonies
 - 1 car broken into at Blackhawk soccer field, wallet stolen
 - 1 check book stolen, checks passed fraudulently
 - 1 car tires slashed in homeowner's driveway
4. 4 misdemeanors
 - Draeger store wine thefts (2) – both arrested

HOA Report: Melissa Manzo

1. HOA Annual Meeting on August 8, 2022
 - a. 3 Board seats were filled – Rick Marz, Robert Durr, Trudy Neighboron
 - b. Supervisor Andersen presented “The State of the County”
2. Road Repairs will be in place September 13-16
3. Slurry Seal of roads scheduled for Sept. 20-28

Old Business:

1. Speed Control – roads inside Blackhawk are under the control of the Blackhawk HOA. At the recent HOA Board meeting, the project to add fog lines was declined.
2. Golf Cart issues – Melissa Manzo (HOA), Mike Rood (Country Club), and Lt. Schultz (Blackhawk Police) met to discuss golf cart traffic and safety issues. It was agreed that there would be a joint community outreach to educate the community (homeowners, country club members) on the rules and laws surrounding golf carts. This includes speeding, # of riders allowed on a cart, age restrictions, and stopping at stop signs.

New Business:

1. Bill Lipsin was voted in as the new P2A vice-chairman.
2. Panhandling was discussed. It was highlighted that panhandling which is not aggressive that is not threatening or intimidating in nature is not illegal and that, depending on whether it is on public or private property, there are limited actions that can be taken by the Blackhawk Police on this issue.
3. The Blackhawk Police recent fiscal year ended June 30, 2022. Expenses were higher than revenues collected by almost \$50,000. This required the Blackhawk Police to utilize our financial reserves. Ron Banducci has asked the County to provide a 5-year pro forma financial projection so that we can gain a better understanding of the impact of inflation and other expenses on our budget.
