### 5. Agency Reports. The MAC received the following reports:

- a. **Supervisor Glover, Vincent Manuel** – Vincent shared that there had once again been a clean-up of Port Chicago Highway homeless encampment and that they continue to work with the Railroad to try and get it fenced. The pedestrian's improvements on Bailey Road continue. Blockades have been placed by Maylord Road to deter the homeless from parking and hanging out there.
- b. **Contra Costa Sheriff** – There was no report from the Sheriff's office.
- c. **Code Enforcement – Armando** – Armando reported that they have opened 10 new

cases, have closed 9. The homeless “city” by the Willow Pass creek has been cleaned up. He encouraged people to continue to use the Mobile Citizen app.

- d. Golden State Water – Tina Gonzalez** – Tina reported that there will be a public hearing on September 9, on zoom. We should have received a postcard about free virtual leak detection.

- 6. Members Reports-** Members brought up the following concerns;
