Minutes of Meeting on September 12, 2023

The P-5 Advisory Committee was held at Round Hill Country Club. Rick Kopf called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Minutes of the August 8, 2023 meeting were approved unanimously.

Public Comment: none

Financial Report: Mark Young reported that the recently revised County generated financial report although not as detailed as the report he has been providing the Committee will be distributed at future monthly meetings. He will add supplemental reports on a quarterly basis as necessary if the information from the County is indicative of any dramatic changes in projected costs or revenue. He also suggested a modification to the payment source for the Flock cameras and made a motion to use the Traffic Safety Fund for Deputy training and new equipment for traffic enforcement in the P-5 District and additionally to use funds from the General Account to fund the Flock cameras installation and maintenance. This motion was seconded by Jason Hill and carried unanimously.

P-5 Activity Report: Deputy Torres discussed the incident report which included a residential burglary in Round Hill North and a fraud to a Resident involving an international transaction. Both are under continuing investigation.

Last meeting the Committee discussed with Deputy Torres the issue of the use of radar and lidar by the Deputies and as a result new equipment has been sourced and training is scheduled to be completed by the end of October.

There were 80 hours of overtime and there was 1 hour and 56 minutes of out of area assistance in the August reporting time frame.

Flock Cameras and ALPR cameras were in service but there were no incidents of stolen vehicles or suspect vehicles in the month of August.

During the month of August Sheriff's Volunteers did patrol the Round Hill streets and issued warning notices but the exact numbers were not compiled.

Old Business: Cameron Collins updated the Committee on the consolidation issues for the police districts in Alamo. The necessity to canvas the P2-B Residents in the near future to evaluate their support of a supplemental tax increase to support additional patrol deputies is critical to a decision to put the issue to the voters in the November 2024 election.
