CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL ESCORT

This permit does not authorize travel unless the move is accompanied by a California Highway Patrol representative. This CHP involvement is reimbursable under contract with the Golden Gate Division of the CHP (Phone 707-648-4180) in accordance with Section 2410.5 of the California Vehicle Code.

ROUTE SURVEY

Prior to commencing this move, the Permittee shall conduct a survey of the entire route to be traveled to locate and list in writing any actual, or potential, obstructions. An "obstruction" includes, but is not limited to wires, trees, traffic signs, traffic control devices, traffic islands, legally parked vehicles, mail boxes, fences, utility poles, or any other object that causes the permitted move to encroach into adjacent, or opposing, traffic lanes, or travel onto curbs or sidewalks. A copy of this route survey shall be provided to the Public Works Representative prior to permit issuance, and shall become a part of the permit.

VIOLATION OF PERMIT

Any incident caused by the failure of the Permittee to properly survey and locate any obstruction, and/or to take action to avoid an obstruction, shall be considered a violation of this permit and the Permittee shall be subject to a traffic ticket and fine.

An "incident" includes, but is not limited to:

1. Vehicular, or property damage;
2. Delay of travel;
3. Detour from route;
4. Travel on curbs or sidewalks without specific permission from the agency having jurisdiction over the curb or sidewalk.

PERSON-IN-CHARGE

The Permittee shall designate a person who shall be in charge of the move. It shall be the duty of the Person-In-Charge to coordinate the entire move, and to arrange with the CHP representative for any minor traffic control that may be necessary for the safe movement of this load.

The Person-In-Charge shall provide the CHP representative with the following:

1. Two-way radio communication with the person-in-charge;
2. A written description, or marked map, showing the entire route to be traveled.

VEHICLE INSPECTION

The Permittee shall check with the California Highway Patrol and satisfy their safety requirements prior to the start of the move.
