Park Dedication and Park Impact Fees

What are the Fees collected for?

Park Fees are collected to fund the acquisition and development of parks in Contra Costa County to serve unincorporated County residents.

What Fees are required?

Park Impact Fees: All residential projects are required to pay a Park Impact fee. The amount depends on dwelling type and location. See table and map below.



| Housing Type | West/Central County | East County |

| Single Family Detached | \$8,292 | \$6,749 |
| Townhome | \$6,595 | \$5,368 |

^{*}Second Units, Affordable Units, and Inclusionary Housing Units may be eligible for waivers or exemptions.

Park Dedication Fees: Residential projects requiring a development plan or subdivision may also require dedication of parkland or in-lieu fees (Quimby Act). Fees paid or land value of parkland may be applied as a credit towards Park Impact fees above. The following outlines Park Dedication land dedication requirement and in-lieu fees. Land and Fees assessed depends on dwelling type and location.

| Housing Type | Parkland Dedication | West/Central County Fee | East County Fee |
|------------------------|---------------------|-------------------------|-----------------|
| Single Family Detached | 391 sq ft/unit | \$4,489 | \$3,142 |
| Townhome | 311 sq ft/unit | \$3,571 | \$2,499 |
| Multi Family | 282 sq ft/unit | \$3,233 | \$2,263 |
| Mobile Home | 263 sq ft /unit | \$3,014 | \$2,109 |

^{*}Second Units, Affordable Units, and Inclusionary Housing Units may be eligible for waivers or exemptions.
