



Temporary Water Outage Necessary Relocation of Water Line at Morgan Territory Rd.

To complete the relocation of your temporary water line out of the slide area on Morgan Territory Road to allow for future road repairs, we must **temporarily interrupt your water service between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Thursday, April 27.** This work is being done ahead of future road repairs to be completed in the affected area.

The Contra Costa Water District apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause. Crews will be working efficiently and will reinstate your service as quickly as possible. Once water service returns, you may temporarily experience air bubbles in your tap water. Please be assured this is normal and is no cause for concern. Open a faucet and let the water run for a few minutes until the water bubbles clear.

If you have equipment in your home that requires water, please turn it off prior to the scheduled shutdown. If you expect to be home during the outage period, we recommend that you fill some large containers with water prior to 10 a.m. Thursday, April 27 so that you can have water available if you need it. This water could be used for drinking, household needs or flushing the toilet by refilling the tank manually.
