The Contra Costa Resource Conservation District (CCRCD) has an immediate opening for an individual interested in serving on its Board of Directors. The CCRCD's mission is to facilitate conservation and stewardship of the natural resources in our county. CCRCD is a state legislated special district governed under Division 9 of the CA Public Resources Code, which stipulates that a Director must be a registered voter in California and:

- 1) Reside within the County and either own real property in the county or have served for two years or more as a CCRCD Associate director

or

- 2) Be a designated agent of a resident landowner within the County.

Qualified candidates with a demonstrated interest in watershed conservation are encouraged to apply. The County Board of Supervisors will make the appointment to fill the vacancy of the opened term expiring on November 30, 2020.
