



## CHARGING STATIONS FOR PEOPLE WITH ELECTRONIC DURABLE MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

Many Contra Costa residents rely on electronic durable medical equipment to stay alive. During the power outage, please ask your medically vulnerable clients the questions below to help ensure their health and reduce visits to ER.

1. Have you contacted family and friends not affected by the power outage that you can stay with or have them help charge equipment?
2. Have you called your medical supplier/vendor for backup equipment or batteries?
3. Can you reach one of these local charging stations: (See list below. People will need to bring your own cords. Some locations might have difficulty with certain equipment)
