Andrew H. Young Park was dedicated as a memorial to Andrew H. Young, president of the Contra Costa County Historical Society. He was devoted to improving the features of Alamo and foster community pride for residents. This park is located near the Alamo Plaza Shopping Center at the intersection of Danville Boulevard and Jackson Way in Alamo and is the site of an annual tree lighting ceremony in December.

- ◇ Take CA-4 E toward Stockton/Interstate 680
- ◇ Merge onto CA-4 E 
- ◇ Take Exit 12B to merge onto South I-680 toward San Jose

- ◇ Turn right onto Livorna Road 
- ◇ Turn left onto Danville Blvd
