



## UAS Bay Area Test Site (BATS)

### What is BATS?

The Contra Costa County Airports, Buchanan Field and Byron Airport, are official Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) unmanned aerial system (UAS) test sites due to a partnership with the University of Alaska Fairbanks and the Pan-Pacific Unmanned Aerial System Test Range Complex (PPUTRC). Collaboratively, the Buchanan Field and Byron Airport test locations are referred to as BATS. These airfields offer businesses an unique opportunity to design, develop, and test in both environments are centrally located in the heart of the Bay Area.



## Why BATS?

- **Location, Location, Location:** Buchanan Field and Byron Airports are located just 30 miles from downtown San Francisco and 50 miles from Silicon Valley.
- **Airspace:** Two different testing environments: Buchanan Field has controlled Class D Airspace and Byron Airport is uncontrolled Class G Airspace, up to 700 feet.
- **Facilities:** Both airports have a selection of offices, workshops and hangars available for short-term and long-term lease.
- **Services:** There are full-service aviation providers at the two facilities that include pilot training, aircraft rental, aircraft maintenance, avionics, fabrication, aircraft storage, fuel, and other specialty aviation services.
- **Relationships and Support:** Proven track record with the Federal Aviation Administration, support at the County's highest political level and staff concierge service, and partnership with the University of Alaska Fairbanks and the Pan-Pacific Unmanned Aerial System Test Range Complex (PPUTRC)

- \* Home of Skyview Aviation, Bay Area Skydiving, Patriot Jet Team, & Northern California Soaring Association
- \* General Aviation Hangars
- \* Hangar and office space development opportunities
- \* 24-hour 100 Low Lead Avgas Self Serve
- \* Airport property is 1,427 acres with 924 acres for habitat management lands

# San Francisco Bay Area unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) airspace restrictions:
