Personal Space and Mentoring



Proposed

- Greater opportunity for personal space
- Personal/private bathroom with water fountain
- Safer environment during sleeping hours and during emergencies
- More opportunities for rapport building
- Significant reduction of escape risk/AWOL acceptance

Restoration of the Family Unit

- Centrally located and closer proximity to more families (74% of current youth from Central/West County)
- More opportunities for reunification
- More flexibility with visiting
- Greater opportunities to attend meetings





Greater Access to Service and Support Providers



- Psychiatric services
- More access to:
 - Pastoral and chaplaincy services
 - Medical and Dental Care
 - Behavioral Health
 - Educational opportunities
- Closer access to Medical emergency services
- Eliminates W&I 778 removals from current site
- Could reduce removals for problematic behaviors or new charges

Home Like Environment


- Personalized rooms

- Increased personal responsibility



