

# CAB Priorities

## 1. Policy Reform

- a. Influence county towards a debt-free criminal justice system
- b. Consider adding focus on juvenile system/recidivism
- c. Advocate to Sheriff to improve the quality of in-custody and reentry programs

## 2. CAB and Office of Reentry & Justice

- a. Help CAB understand relationship with ORJ
- b. Clarify ORJ's role in relationship to CAB's priorities and action

## 3. CAB and Board of Supervisors

- a. Influence county's legislative platform as appropriate
- b. Increase CAB outreach to and access with BOS

## 4. Community Engagement

- a. Clarify CAB's priorities re: receiving information and raising public awareness, community education

## 5. CAB Development and Planning

- a. Fully staff CAB subcommittees
- b. Develop plan to avoid CAB brain drain as people cycle off CAB
- c. Revisit unfinished CAB goals

## 6. CAB and Community Based Organizations

- a. Engage more closely with CBOs (fully resourced, quality assurance, alignment with CAB recommendations)
- b. Educate CAB members about CBOs
- c. Increase CAB's knowledge of evidence-based practices (EBPs)
- d. Evaluate to ensure CBO's and County are using evidence-based practices (EBPs)

## 7. Data

- a. Increase data sharing and data quality between County and CBOs
- b. Influence interface of data sharing with CAB
- c. Improve data access for CAB
