COUNT 1 – VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER

The undersigned states, on information and belief, that Phyllis Harvey Meehan, Defendant, did commit a Misdemeanor, a violation of PC192(c)(1), Vehicular Manslaughter, committed as follows:
